

Partners of Stoughton Hospital introduced Izzy to the twiddle muff, designed to sooth, calm, and distract her from hair pulling, by offering a brightly knitted muff of various textures, containing ribbons, buttons, etc., which allows her to focus her energies on the twiddle muff, offering plenty of tactile stimulation while keeping her hands busy.
